Study Visit Press Release Bari (Apulia, Italy)

A one day study visit has been held in Bari on May 28th 2025, as part of the ADRIAMOVE project (an acronym in English for 'Development of sustainable mobility to improve electric transport in the Mediterranean Ionian area'), funded by the INTERREG - IPA ADRION 2021 - 2027 programme (web: https://adriamove.interreg-ipa-adrion.eu).

Sustainable urban mobility policies, strategies and actions have been the focus of the day.

The Municipality of Fasano, as lead partner, brought the representatives of the international project partners (Municipality of Dugopoglie, Croatia, Municipality of Postojna, Slovenia, Municipality of Gjirokastra, Albania, Municipality of Centar Sarajevo, Bosnia Herzegovina, Municipality of Budva, Montenegro, Ismail Qemali University of Vlore, Albania) to observe and analyse the policies implemented in the City of Bari, in order to acquire and exchange knowledge and experiences.



Engineer Mr. Domenico Scaramuzzi, Branch Director for the Municipality of Bari, with the support of the Department Manager Engineer Giulio Binetti passionately and expertly accompanied the group for the entire day, illustrating, both with classroom lectures and site visits, the complex of infrastructural works, incentives, measures and projects that are transforming the City of Bari.

The day has ended with a practical experience on the use of part of the extensive intermodality and interchange system, using various means of transport, such as e-bikes, scooters and buses.
