Study Visit Press Release Budva (Montenegro)

Within the framework of the ADRIAMOVE project (English acronym for 'Development of sustainable mobility to improve electric transport in the Mediterranean Ionian area'), financed by the INTERREG - IPA ADRION 2021 - 2027 programme (web: <https://adriamove.interreg-ipa-adrion.eu>), the second study day on sustainable urban mobility policies, strategies and actions implemented by the Municipality of Budva was held on last 17 June 2025 in Budva, Montenegro. The first study visit was held in Bari on 28 May 2025.

The delegation representing the Municipality of Fasano (Project Lead Partner) was composed by Project Manager Dr. Giuseppe Pugliese, from the Municipality's Public Works sector, and Dr. Gianmaria Latorre as a local stakeholder on behalf of the tour operator 'Indigenus'.

Also Professors Nunzio Angiola and Piervito Bianchi from the University of Foggia, Project Partner, were there from Apulia region.

The Municipality of Budva, similarly to the Municipality of Fasano, has been experiencing a strong increase in the number of tourists in recent years, which therefore needs to be managed in terms of mobility and logistics, in order to make its

impact more sustainable. This is one of the objectives the ADRIAMOVE project intends to manage.
